Week 1 is limited to 6 crews (5 bus and 1 driving)

Your Tinnerman Crew

Your maximum crew size is eight (8) participants and must include a minimum of 2 adults, with a max of 3 adults.

Participants must be at least 13 years old by January 1st of the year they attend.

“Two deep” leadership policy is in effect for all crews traveling to Tinnerman. For all Boy Scout crews, one adult crew leader must be age 21 or older. Venturing co-ed crews must provide an adult, age 21 or older, male leader and an adult, age 21 or older, female leader regardless of the crew size.

All Scouts, Venturers, and leaders must be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of America. All participants must be able to pass the BSA swimmers’ test, and have a current physical exam within one year. Medical form must be signed and dated by the doctor.

Crews must have a person trained in CPR and Standard First Aid as well as a leader trained in Safety Afloat and Safe Swim Defense.
